### Purpose of Scenario-based Testing

- The Blueprint will require that states submit the results testing
- Testing will be comprised of CMS-developed test scenarios, state IV&V results, and outcomes of state testing
- CMS is leveraging test scenarios as due diligence for approving or conditionally approving State Based Exchanges




### Overview of the Use of Scenario-based Testing


- The Blueprint will be used as the basis for designing CMS-developed test scenarios
- CMS-developed scenarios will address those Exchange Activities that require standardization across all states

### Test Scenario Process Designed to Validate Exchange Functions

Test Scenario written to provide real-world trial situations to assess specific function of the Exchange



Business Process and IT **Designs** used to carry out test scenario and assess specific Exchange function



Test Scenario Outcomes determined by whether function being assessed was proven or disproven by the test scenario





### **Test Scenario Progress to Date**

- A Test Scenario State Working Group has been formed and initialized meetings to discuss general testing strategies and plans to incorporate CMS-developed test scenarios into those testing strategies
  - Objective of the working group is to disseminate best testing practices from states that have been progressive in their approaches; a few of these states are part of this session
  - Working group leads help states balance required testing (with CMS) developed test scenarios) with flexibility to tailor testing approaches to individual state needs
- Timeline for required testing with CMS-developed test scenarios
  - Initial test scenarios delivery scheduled for Summer 2012
