Dear Director Perreira-Eustaquio:

On December 30, 2016, the Department of Health & Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Hawaii's State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Hawaii's approved application waives the ACA's requirement that a Small Business Health Options Program (SHOP) operate in Hawaii, and other related requirements relevant to SHOP Exchanges, for plan years 2017 through 2021. More recently, on December 10, 2021, the Departments approved Hawaii's request to extend its section 1332 waiver through 2026.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that, after application of sequestration at the fiscal year 2022 rate of 5.7 percent (\$1,783.30), Hawaii's net pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2022 is \$29,502.70.

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This letter is to notify you that the pass-through funding associated with this waiver for calendar year 2022 is estimated to be \$31,286, which must be used for purposes of implementing Hawaii's State Innovation Waiver. This amount will be subject to a final administrative determination by the Department of the Treasury prior to payment. In addition, this amount will be subject to fiscal year 2022 sequestration. As a result, amounts payable in fiscal year 2022 will be reduced by 5.7 percent.
