LTCH Care Compare Refresh with Revised DTC Measure Data

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) discovered an error in measure calculations for the Discharge to Community (DTC)-Post Acute Care (PAC) Long-Term Care Hospital Quality Reporting Program (LTCH QRP) measure, and are re-releasing the corrected measure data in a refresh scheduled for **September 29**, **2021**. The data are based on Medicare claims data submitted to CMS for the **FY2018-2019 reporting period** (01/01/2017-09/30/2019).

LTCH QRP: Non-Compliance Notifications

Non-compliance notifications will be distributed by the Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) and will be placed into facilities' My Reports folders in the Internet Quality Improvement and Evaluation System (iQIES) on July 14, 2021. Facilities that receive a letter of non-compliance may submit a request for reconsideration to CMS via email no later than 11:59 pm, August 13, 2021. If you receive a notice of non-compliance and would like to request a reconsideration, see the instructions in your notification letter and on the LTCH Quality Reporting Reconsideration and Exception & Extension webpage.

Please note: Any reconsideration containing protected health information (PHI) will not be processed. All PHI must be removed in order for a reconsideration to be reviewed.
