Notice is hereby given that on January 13, 2020, the Medicare provider agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Patients' Hospital of Redding, as a provider of General Acute Care Hospital under the Health Insurance Benefits Program of the Aged and Disabled (Medicare), will be terminated effective 12:01 a.m. on January 13, 2020. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has determined that Patients' Hospital of Redding is not in compliance with regulatory requirements for participation as a General Acute Care Hospital in the Medicare Program (Title XVIII of the Social Security Act).

No payment for hospital services rendered to Medicare and/or Medicaid beneficiaries admitted for services on or after 12:01 a.m. January 13, 2020. To facilitate the appropriate movement and placement of Medicare and/or Medicaid patients in your facility upon termination of your Medicare provider agreement, payments for services to Medicare and/or Medicaid residents who were admitted to your facility prior to the effective date of termination may be permitted for up to a maximum of thirty (30) days after the effective date of termination.
