Home Health Quality Measures

NOTE: Medicare-certified HHAs are required to participate in the HH QRP by participating and reporting <u>both</u> OASIS (patient quality of care) measures and HHCAHPS (patient survey results) measures. The HHCAHPS measures are from a 34-question survey. CMS groups the measures by topic into three composite measures and two overall measures. CMS publicly reports the HHCAHPS on <u>Care Compare</u> (ZIP), and they are called "patient survey results" on the compare site. The five measures are: (1) Care of Patients, (2) Communications between Providers and Patients, (3) Specific Care Issues, (4) Overall Rating of Care, and (5) Patient willingness to recommend HHA to family and friends.
