Title Notice to the Public of Revocation of O'Hare Clinical Labs CLIA Certificate

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The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on August 15, 2022, the O'Hare Clinical Labs CLIA certificate was revoked due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements.

The facility has been notified that the CLIA certificate was revoked on August 15, 2022. When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is revoked, it is required to cease all patient laboratory testing, including waived and provider performed microscopy testing and regardless of whether or not the laboratory charges for the testing. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care.
