



Medicare and Medicaid Notice to the Public

Notice is hereby given that on February 25, 2022 the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Momentous Health at Battle Creek, Battle Creek, MI as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program. In addition, notice is given that the provider's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will also be terminated effective February 25, 2022.

CMS has determined that Momentous Health at Battle Creek has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements:

- 42 CFR 483.12 – Freedom from Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation
- 42 CFR 483.15 – Notice Required before Transfer/Discharge
- 42 CFR 483.20 – Accuracy of Assessments/Resident Records
- 42 CFR 483.21 – Discharge Summary
- 42 CFR 483.24 – Activities/Daily Living
- 42 CFR 483.75 – QAPI Program
- 42 CFR 483.80 – Antibiotic Stewardship
- 42 CFR 483.90 – Safe/Functional/Sanitary Environment

The Medicare program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after October 7, 2021. This date is due to a previously imposed denial of payment for new admissions. For residents admitted prior to October 7, 2021, payment may continue to be made for up to 30 days of services after February 25, 2022, the date of termination.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after October 7, 2021. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to October 7, 2021, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after February 25, 2022, the date of termination.

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
