SUBJECT: Release of Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 State Performance Standards System (SPSS)
Results

Memorandum Summary

- **SPSS Results:** The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is releasing the SPSS results for FY2018. These results include three years of performance evaluations based on 18 measures from FY2016 to FY2018.

Background

State Agencies (SAs) conduct survey activities under agreements with the Secretary based on federal statutes, regulations and guidance to ensure the health and safety of all individuals receiving services by Medicare or Medicaid certified providers and suppliers (e.g., hospitals, nursing homes, home health, hospice, and ESRD facilities). The SPSS is a three-dimensional domain structure (frequency, quality, and enforcement and remedy) that provides a framework to organize and measure important aspects of SA survey activities. These three dimensions also support our efforts to standardize and promote consistency among SAs. Every year, CMS conducts a formal assessment of each SA's performance relative to measures included in the SPSS program. CMS works with the SAs to strengthen oversight so that the care provided in nursing homes and/or by providers and suppliers is of the highest quality. Results

The attached SPSS results present the last three fiscal year performance results for 52 jurisdictions. The evaluations are based on 18 measures which are grouped under the three-dimensional structure. There are six frequency, four enforcement and remedy, and eight quality measures.

Below are summaries of key findings for FY 2018:

- 46 percent of States met the requirements for the frequency of nursing home standard surveys;

- 39 percent of States met the requirements for timeliness of complaint and incident investigations for nursing homes with Non-Immediate Jeopardy High prioritization level for which the survey started in ten working days;
- 89 percent of States met the requirements for standard surveys of intermediate care facilities for individuals who are intellectually disabled;
- 96 percent of States met the requirements for hospital validation surveys;
- 81 percent of States met the requirements for processing of termination cases for non-nursing home providers and suppliers;
- 73 percent of States met the requirements for prioritizing Intakes for Home Health Agencies, End-Stage Renal Disease, and hospitals; and,
- 98 percent of States met the requirements for frequency of hospice surveys.

We note that many more states did not meet the required frequency of nursing home standard surveys for FY 2018 than in previous years. Our analysis shows this is likely due to the implementation of a new long term care survey process (LTCSP) launched in November 2017, coupled with new regulations that required increased time for training on and implementation of the new process. For example, 12 states did not meet this requirements for the first time in three years. In general, these states took longer to conduct surveys in the first half of the year, then became more efficient in the second half of the year. We believe this is due to surveyors taking time to learn the new process and regulations, but also reflects their ability to bounce back and improve efficiency. As a result, we expect more states to meet this requirement in FY 2019.

We further note that the number of facility-reported incidents and complaint investigations have continued to rise year after year, impacting states' ability to conduct these investigations timely. These complaints have increased approximately 20 percent since 2013, yet funding for these inspections has not increased since 2015. We are asking Congress for additional funding to help states conduct these investigations. Separately, we plan to issue guidance related to managing and investigating facility-reported incidents and complaints, to help states to prioritize and investigate these issues. We are also reviewing the LTCSP to increase efficiencies so that survey teams may complete their work in a timely manner.

There are other factors that can affect state survey performance, such as training, staffing vacancies, volume of complaint surveys, and staff tenure. These results do not assess such factors. Rather, the results merely report whether a State met the measurement criteria. Regardless, CMS is always concerned about the impact that performance issues can have on beneficiaries' health and safety. The Regional Offices (ROs) work with their respective states to understand why states did not meet certain requirements and outline corrective actions that will be taken to improve performance. Some of the steps for improving performance include survey scheduling revisions, surveyor compensation enhancements, new recruitment strategies, and surveyor training. The ROs also increase communication with SAs and conduct site visits to support improved performance.

When efforts such at these have been unsuccessful, CMS may take actions related to the federal funds that are distributed to states. For example, rather than provide the traditional budgeted funding upfront, CMS may withhold funding until a state meets certain performance benchmarks. Or, CMS may enter into a Systems Improvement Agreement with a state that may

include specific expectations, such as hiring outside consultants to perform a root cause analysis to identify areas of concerns, and develop a corrective action plan to address performance shortcomings. CMS has also provided contractor assistance to certain states to provide onsite consultation and assistance to help address programmatic issues. In circumstances where none of the interventions identified above proved to be successful, the Regional Offices will initiate communication both in writing and verbally with State senior leadership, including State Governors, to provide information about the unresolved state challenges and engage in further solution driven communications.

Planned Improvements to the SPSS

CMS is evaluating the entire State Performance Standards System to identify ways to improve State agency performance. Since implementing the new LTCSP in 2017, we now have more robust data that can be used to monitor and improve performance. We are also looking to tailor certain aspects of the program to address certain state-specific needs. The resulting updates to the SPSS aim to enable CMS, SAs, and ROs to address areas of concern more effectively, and ultimately improve beneficiary safety and quality of care. We expect these changes to be implemented over the next couple of years, beginning in FY 2020.
