Notice to the Public of Medicare Termination

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on September 6, 2019, “Hahnemann University Hospital” located at 230 North Broad Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, 19102, voluntarily terminated its participation in Medicare as a provider of hospital services. Accordingly, its agreement with the Secretary of Health & Human Services is voluntarily terminated, effective **September 6, 2019**.

In addition, CMS has determined that Hahnemann University Hospital does not meet the requirements for participation as a hospital in the Medicare program established under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act (the Act). Under the provisions of 42 C.F.R. §§ 489.53(a)(1) and 489.53(a)(18), Hahnemann University Hospital’s Medicare provider agreement with the Secretary of Health and Human Services is hereby involuntarily terminated effective **October 22, 2019**, which is 15 days after the date of this notice.

In order to participate in the Medicare program as a hospital, a facility must meet the statutory definition of a hospital set out in § 1861(e) of the Social Security Act (Act), 42 U.S.C. § 1395x(e), and must be in compliance with each of the applicable regulatory Conditions of Participation for hospitals at 42 C.F.R. Part 482.

Hahnemann University Hospital was notified, on October 4, 2019, that effective October 22, 2019, its Medicare provider agreement with the Secretary of Health and Human Services is involuntarily terminated.

Hahnemann University Hospital has sixty (60) days, from date of its notice, to appeal CMS’s action to involuntarily terminate its Medicare provider agreement.
