#### Notice to the Public of Medicare Termination

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that Continental Home Health Care does not meet the requirements for participation as a provider of services in the Health Insurance Program for the Aged and Disabled (Medicare) established under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act (the ACT). In order to participate in the Medicare program as a home health agency, a home health agency must meet all the provisions of Section 1861 (o) of the Act [42 U.S.C. § 1395x(o)], not limited to but including being “primarily engaged in providing skilled nursing services and other therapeutic services. Social Security Act § 1861(o)(1) [42 U.S.C. § 1395x(o)(1)]. In addition, the agency must be in compliance with each of the conditions of participation established by the Secretary of Health & Human Services at 42 C.F.R. Part 484, be free of hazards to the health and safety of patients, and meet such other requirements as shall be established by law or regulation.

Continental Home Health Care’s Medicare provider agreement with the Secretary of Health and Human Services is hereby involuntarily terminated effective **October 22, 2019**, which is 15 days after the date of this notice.

Continental Home Health Care was notified, on October 7, 2019, that effective October 22, 2019, its Medicare provider agreement with the Secretary of Health and Human Services is involuntarily terminated. Continental Home Health Care has sixty (60) days, from date of its notice, to appeal CMS’s action to involuntarily terminate its Medicare provider agreement.
