Use code 09, Not applicable, because Mr. L did not walk prior to the current episode of care and did not walk during the 3-day assessment period. Because GG0170I, Walk 10 feet, is coded 09, follow the skip pattern to GG0170Q1 (admission) or GG0170Q3 (discharge), Does the patient use a wheelchair and/or scooter? Mr. L’s care plan includes fitting and use of bilateral prostheses and walking as a goal.
